
### **Online survey**

The Commission has completed its Inquiry into A fair chance for all: Breaking the cycle of persistent disadvantage. An independent evaluation has been carried out against our performance framework set out in the 2022-23 Statement of Performance Expectations. The evaluation used three external sources of feedback: an expert review, participant interviews and online survey. This report presents the results from the online survey, which was run in August and September 2023.

The online survey was sent to people who met with the inquiry team, made a submission on the terms of reference and interim report, attended inquiry workshops and seminars, or who wanted to be kept informed about the inquiry's work and findings. Just over 1,200 people were invited to participate and 146 participants responded to the survey.

The following report presents the results from the online survey. Answers to questions that allowed a free-text response have been removed to protect the privacy of respondents. However, these answers were used to inform the independent evaluation's findings and recommendations.


### Q1 What type of organisation do you primarily represent?





### Q3 Have you engaged with the Commission on any previous inquiries?





# Q4 The Fair chance for all inquiry has increased my understanding of persistent disadvantage.






























